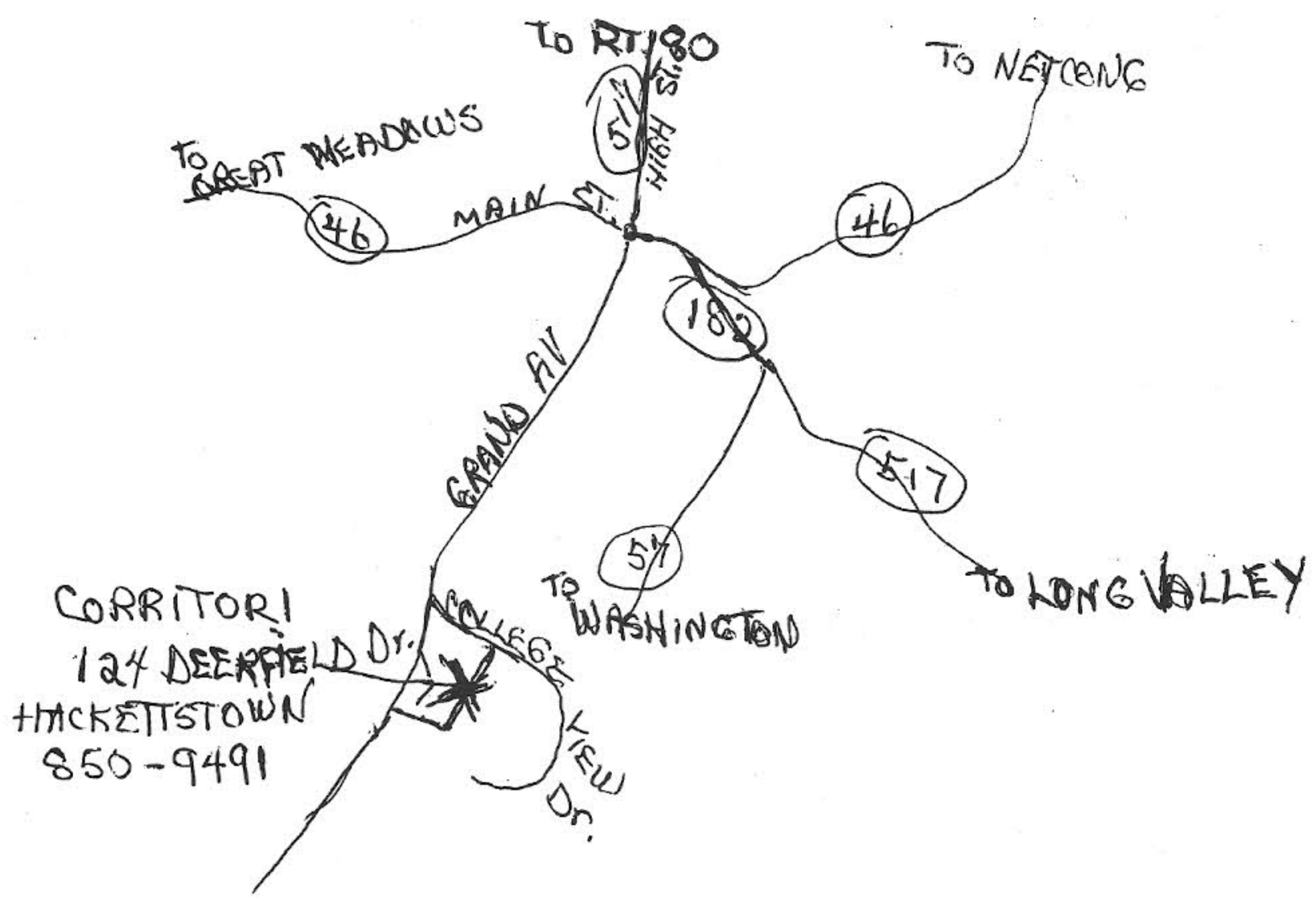

"Will of Samuel Swackhammer, taken from "Documents Relating to the Colonial, Revolutionary, and Post-Revolutionary History of the State of New Jersey , First Series - Vol. XXXV, Calendar of New Jersey Wills, Administration, Etc. Volume VI - 1781-1785, Edited and Indexed by Elmer T. Hitchinson, Corresponding Secretary, New Jersey Historical Society, on file at the Camden County Historical Society, Camden, New Jersey. Page 383:

1780. Feb. 1. Swackhammer, Samuel, of Lebanon, Hunterdon Co.; will of. Eldest son, Conrad, 20 shillings. Son, John, 50 shillings. Daughter, Caterine Carns, 5 shillings. Daughter, Eve Shelor, 5 shillings. Daughter, Ann Leeke, 5 shillings. Daughter, Dolley Terubury, 5 shillings. Daughter, Elizabeth Tufford, 5 shillings. Wife, Elizabeth, 1/3 of moveable estate. Daughter, Caterine, profits of my farm, and, after her death, to be sold, and money given to my children, Barbery, Elizabeth, Hellena, Bollus, Samuel, Andrew, Jacob, and Daniel. Executors: son-in-law, Daniel Sims, and brother-in-law, Fredrick Miller. Witnesses - Joseph Snider, Sarah Clymer, Charles Heldebrand. Proved March 8, 1782.
