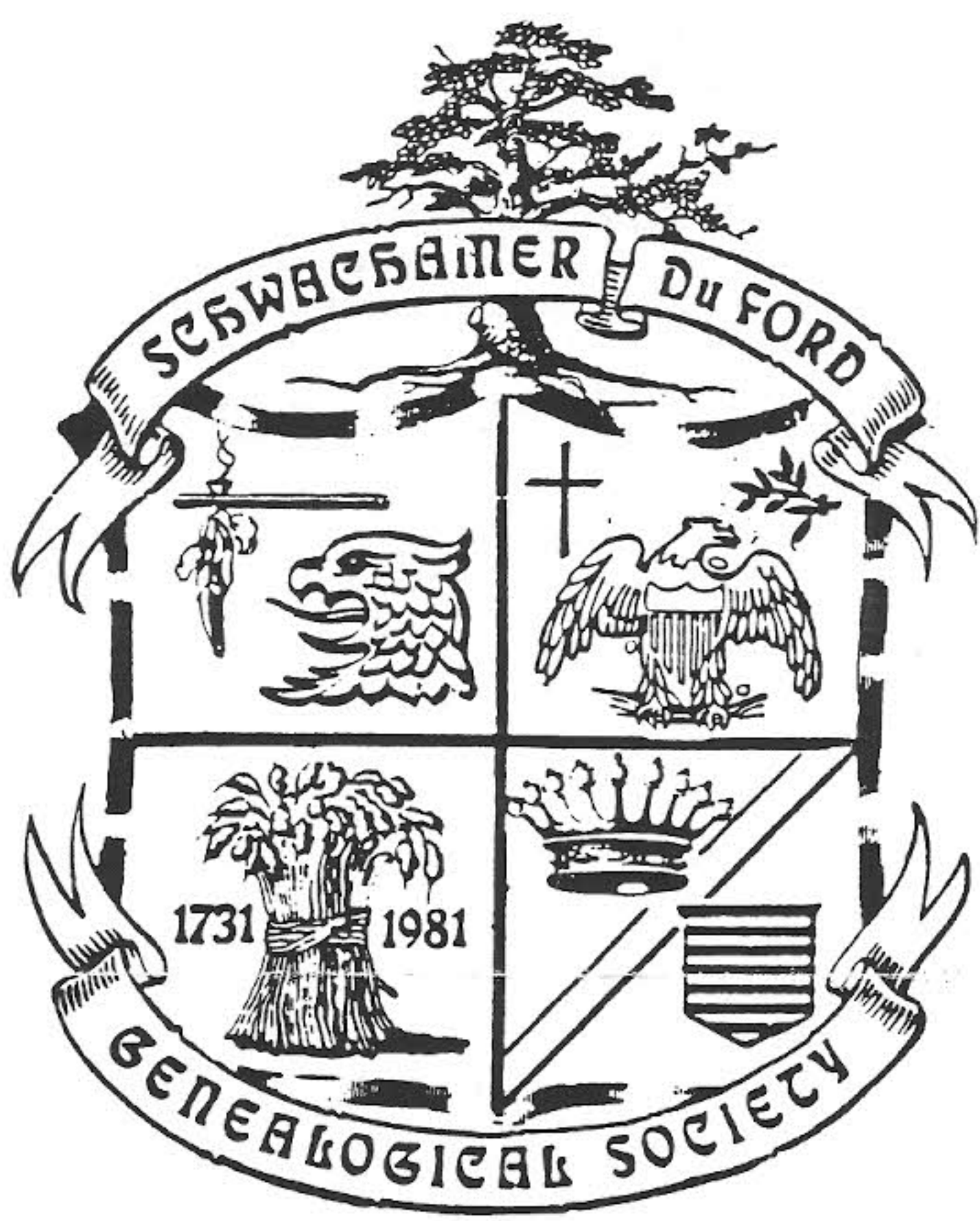

THE TUFFORD FAMILY IN NORTH AMERICA  
...Variations on the name...

The theory is that variations on a name were due to lack of accurate spellings and the tendency to write phonetically.

Emigration:

On ship "Robert and Alice" from Rotterdam in 1738, two Palatine passengers were listed, Philip Toffer and Jacob Toffer. On arrival in Philadelphia, the German records show Philip Tofort and Jacob Tofort: the Oath list by the English shows Philip Thiffort and Jacob Thiffort, Jr.

Early History:

A will filed in New Jersey, February 15, 1767 of Philip Toford (Tufford) Sr. and wife Catrena, names a daughter Mary Magdilene and three sons; Jacob, George and Adam.

Jacob married a Leni Lenape maiden. Most of this family is listed in family charts and records.

Adam's will; 1779, filed in fork township of Northhampton County, PA., names a wife and 8 children (He's assumed to be the son of Philip and Catrena).

George had a wife, Catherine Elizabeth. Little is known about them.

Other Landings:

New Orleans - Jean Dufort 1752

Philadelphia - Jacob Duffordt 1764, ship "Hero"

" - Mr. Duford 1820

New Orleans - Julian Duford 1820 (same ship)

Philadelphia - Benjamin Toffart 1839, Henry Duffort 1856, and Nicholas Duffort 1868.

U.S.A. Families:

Settlers of the Forks of the Delaware, show Tuffart, Siffart, Duffart, Dophard, Dophart and Doffard.

Early New Jersey records show Dufford and Tufford. Pennsylvania records: Tufferd, Tufford, Toffart, Dufford, Doffert, Duffer, Duffart, Duffort, Doffort, Tuffer and Dufort.

Canadian Families:

At least 6 (six) family groups spell their names Tufford and reportedly come from the USA. Conrad and Judy Tufford, with daughter Mary, and others from Bucks County, PA., went to the Niagara Peninsula in 1786. They were granted by the Crown 200 acres, still in the family possession. Conrad and Judy had three sons in Canada: Jacob, Joseph and



Isaac.
